



PRIVACY POLICY

Under the Privacy Act 1988 (Cth), Centro Church is a small business operator, and therefore exempt from the application of the Australian Privacy Principles. Notwithstanding this, Centro Church is committed to protecting your privacy and developing technology that gives you the most powerful and safe online experience. This Statement of Privacy applies to the Centro Church website and governs data collection and usage. By using the Centro Church website, you consent to the data practices described in this statement.

COLLECTION OF YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION

Centro Church collects personally identifiable information, such as your e-mail address, name, home or work address or telephone number. Centro Church also collects anonymous demographic information, which is not unique to you, such as your postcode, age, gender, preferences, interests and favourites.

There is also information about your computer hardware and software that is automatically collected by Centro Church. This information can include: your IP address, browser type, domain names, Centro Church's times and referring website addresses. This information is used by Centro Church for the operation of the service, to maintain quality of the service, and to provide general statistics regarding use of the Centro Church website. In addition, Centro Church may share data with trusted partners to help us perform statistical analysis, send you email or postal

mail, provide customer support, arrange for deliveries, or assist in the provision of other requested products or services.

Please keep in mind that if you directly disclose personally identifiable information or personally sensitive data through Centro Church public message boards, this information may be collected and used by others. Note: Centro Church does not read any of your private online communications.

Centro Church encourages you to review the privacy statements of websites you choose to link to from Centro Church so that you can understand how those websites collect, use and share your information. Centro Church is not responsible for the privacy statements or other content on websites outside of the Centro Church and Centro Church family of websites.

USE OF YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION

Centro Church collects and uses your personal information to operate the Centro Church website and deliver the services you have requested. Centro Church also uses your personally identifiable information to inform you of other products or services available from Centro Church and its affiliates. Centro Church may also contact you via surveys to conduct research about your opinion of current services or of potential new services that may be offered.

Centro Church does not sell, rent or lease its customer lists to third parties. Centro Church may, from time to time, contact you on behalf of external business partners about a particular offering that may be of interest to you. In those cases, your unique personally identifiable information (e-mail, name, address, telephone number) is not transferred to the third party. In addition, Centro Church may share data with trusted partners to help us perform statistical analysis, send you email or postal mail, provide customer support, or arrange for deliveries. All such third parties are prohibited from using your personal information except to provide these services to Centro Church, and they are required to maintain the confidentiality of your information.

Centro Church does not use or disclose sensitive personal information, such as race, religion, or political affiliations, without your explicit consent.

Centro Church keeps track of the websites and pages our customers visit within Centro Church, in order to determine what Centro Church services are the most popular. This data is used to deliver customized content and advertising within Centro Church to customers whose behaviour indicates that they are interested in a particular subject area.

Centro Church websites will disclose your personal information, without notice, only if required to do so by law or in the good faith belief that such action is necessary to: (a) conform to the edicts of the law or comply with legal process served on Centro Church or the site; (b) protect and defend the rights or property of Centro Church; and, (c) act under exigent circumstances to protect the personal safety of users of Centro Church, or the public.

USE OF COOKIES

The Centro Church website uses 'cookies' to help you personalize your online experience. A cookie is a text file that is placed on your hard disk by a web page server. Cookies cannot be used to run programs or deliver viruses to your computer. Cookies are uniquely assigned to you, and can only be read by a web server in the domain that issued the cookie to you.

One of the primary purposes of cookies is to provide a convenience feature to save you time. The purpose of a cookie is to tell the web server that you have returned to a specific page. For example, if you personalize Centro Church pages, or register with Centro Church site or services, a cookie helps Centro Church to recall your specific information on subsequent visits. This simplifies the process of recording your personal information, such as billing addresses, shipping addresses, and so on. When you return to the same Centro Church website, the information you previously provided can be retrieved, so you can easily use the Centro Church features that you customized.

You have the ability to accept or decline cookies. Most web browsers automatically accept cookies, but you can usually modify your browser setting to decline cookies if you prefer. If you choose to decline cookies, you may not be able to fully experience the interactive features of the Centro Church services or websites you visit.

SECURITY OF YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION

Centro Church secures your personal information from unauthorized access, use or disclosure. Centro Church secures the personally identifiable information you provide on computer servers in a controlled, secure environment, protected from unauthorized access, use or disclosure. When personal information (such as a credit card number) is transmitted to other websites, it is protected through the use of encryption, such as the Secure Socket Layer (SSL) protocol.

CHANGES TO THIS STATEMENT

Centro Church will occasionally update this Statement of Privacy to reflect company and customer feedback. Centro Church encourages you to periodically review this Statement to be informed of how Centro Church is protecting your information.
